

Program Overview

Congratulations! You are about to embark on a fantastic, life long journey with your child. You have committed to enjoying books with your child and in the process, reaping the benefits as your child gains pre-literacy skills that will prepare him for reading and learning throughout his life.

How this Program Works

1. Enroll you child at the Saluda County Library and receive your 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten reading log.
2. After each set of 50 books is read and recorded, take your journal to the library to receive your sticker and certificate and pick up your next reading log brochure.
3. When you and your child have read and recorded your 1000th book, take your reading log to the library for your final reward.

You may be asking yourself, “How will I read 1000 books to my child?” 1000 sounds like a big number, however broken down over 2-5 years that is only 1-2 books per day or every other day. This small time commitment is well worth the advantage you will be giving your child and the memories that you will form spending time with him.

Suggestions: Have Fun! Take every chance to read with your children, tell and talk about stories, say nursery rhymes, and sing songs. Expose your children to a variety of different types of stories and vocabulary. You may count the same book multiple times. Read when the experience will be most pleasurable. Children learn best when they are in a good mood.
